



What Health Information Forms do I need for my Child to Attend Pre-K or Kindergarten?

- 1. Immunization Record:** An up-to-date immunization record must be on file with the health room before your child can attend school.
- 2. Health Inventory:** Your child must have a physical 9 months before or within 6 months of starting school. Parent/Guardian completes Part I of the Health Inventory form and then gives it to the doctor to complete Part II.
- 3. Lead Addendum:** The doctor also completes The Lead Addendum form during this visit. If needed, the doctor will order a lead blood test.
- 4. Dental Health Report:** It is recommended that your child begin every 6 months dental check-ups at this age. The Dental Health Report Form is to be signed by a dentist.



Where can I get help if I need it?

Immunizations: Free immunizations are available at the **Frederick County Health Department** for children without a doctor. For appointments call 301-600-3342.

Dentists: The **Frederick County Dental Clinic** provides dental care for children. They accept medical assistance and have a sliding scale payment plan for families without health insurance. 301-600-1041.

Health Insurance: The **Maryland Children's Health Program** gives full health benefits for children up to age 19 and pregnant women. Eligibility is income based. For an application, see your school nurse or call 1-800-456-8900 or 301-600-3124.
